

Earthquake near Myponga 27th July 2018

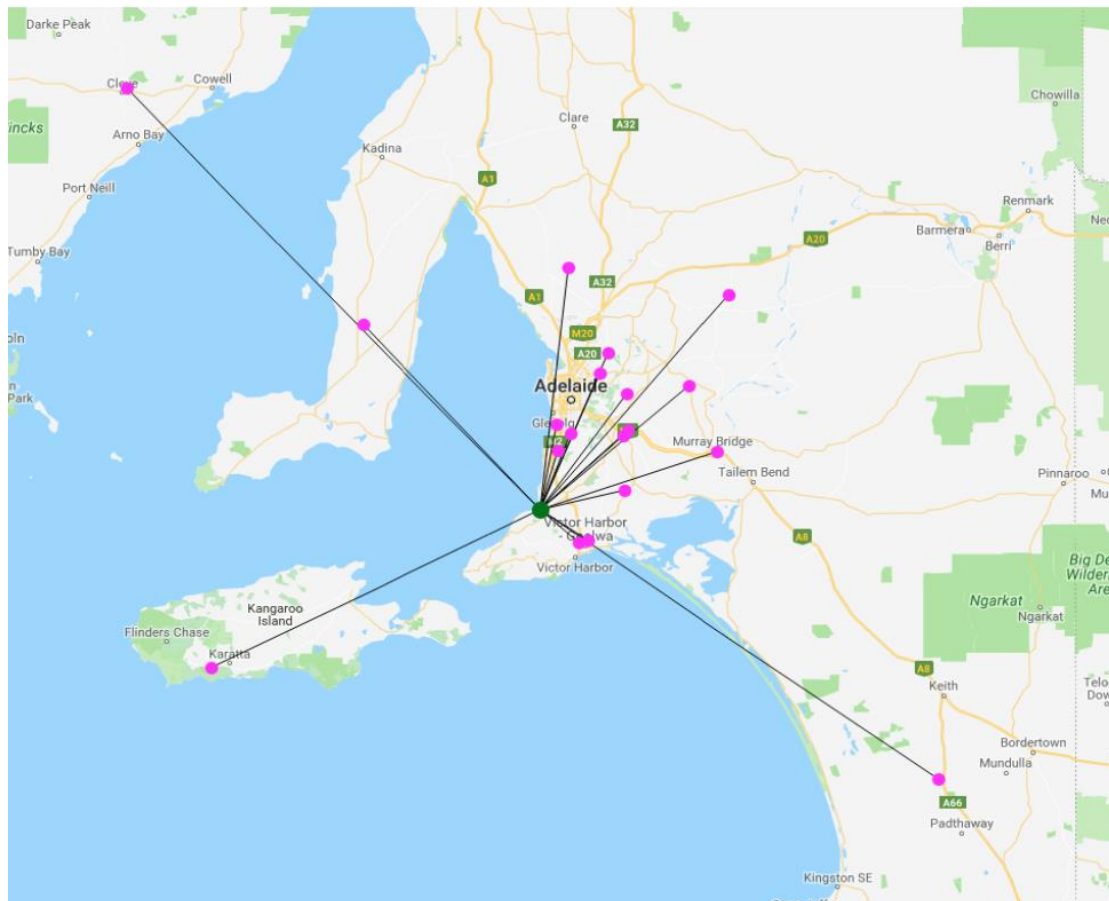

An earthquake occurred near Myponga on 26th July at 23:21UT (8.51 am local time 27-July-2018).

The Seismological Association of Australia calculated that it was centered 3km north-of Myponga, at a depth of about 7km with a magnitude of 2.2.

Many seismographs operated by the Seismological Association, Geoscience Australia, schools and local citizen scientists have recorded the event. The nearest seismographs were at Victor Harbor, Middleton and Morphet Vale, all owned and operated by members of the SAA.



The above map shows the seismographs used to calculate the epicenter of the earthquake from SAA instruments of the location of the event.
