

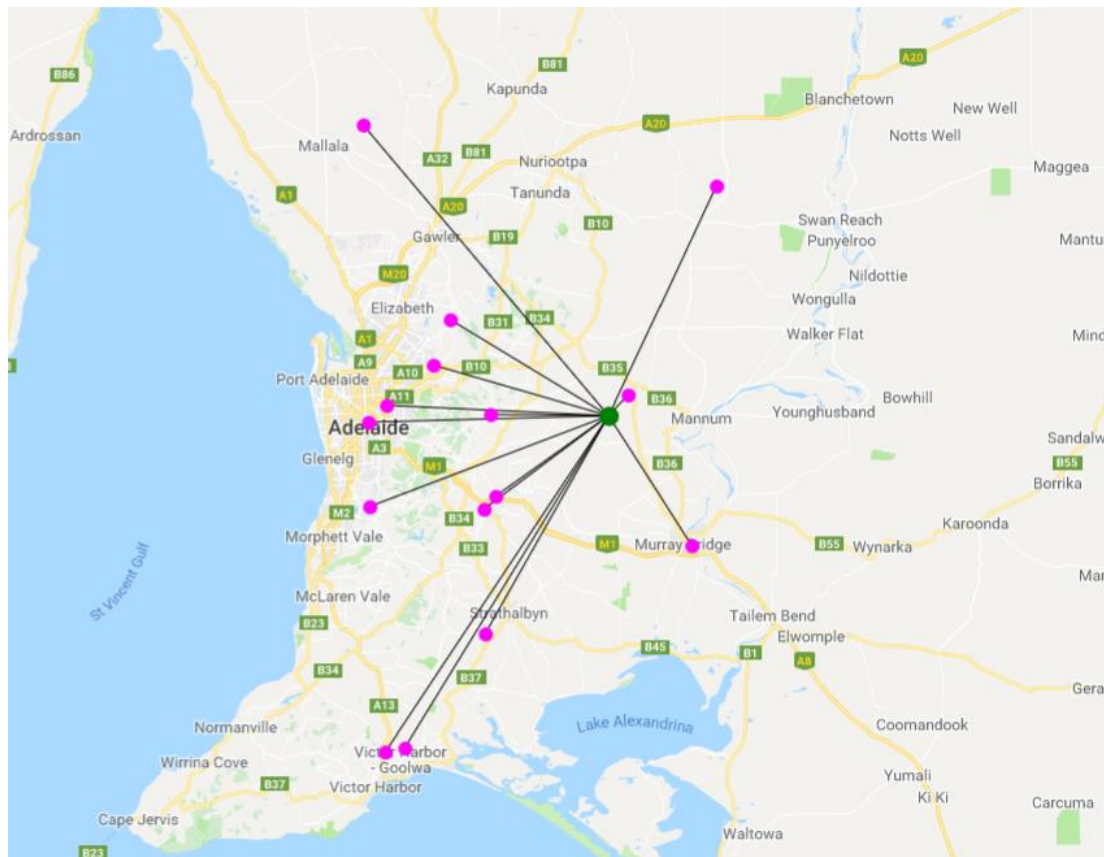
Earthquake near Palmer 8th Aug 2018

Seismological Association of Australia (SAA).

An earthquake occurred near Palmer on 8th August at 11:01UT (8.31 pm local time).

The Seismological Association of Australia calculated that it was centered 7km south west of Palmer, at a depth of about 17.8km with a magnitude of 2.8.

Many seismographs operated by the Seismological Association, Geoscience Australia, schools and local citizen scientists have recorded the event. The nearest seismographs were at Palmer, Upper Tea Tree Gully and Murray Bridge, all owned and operated by members of the SAA.



The above map shows the seismographs used to calculate the epicenter (location) of the earthquake from SAA instruments.
